

## ENTRY PROCEDURES

Printable Entry Forms are available on the IPM website at [www.plowingmatch.org/2016-committees/quilting](http://www.plowingmatch.org/2016-committees/quilting)

**Submit one Entry Form per entry, along with Entry Fee. Must be received by April 15, 2016.**

**Entry Fee of \$10 per entry is non-refundable, and payable by cheque to IPM 2016.** One cheque or money order for multiple entries is acceptable. Youth entries require no fee.

1. Complete one Entry Form per entry.
2. Make TWO COPIES of each completed Entry Form
3. Mail one COPY of the Entry Form, with Entry Fee to:

4. Attach the second COPY to the quilt entry for delivery.
5. Retain the ORIGINAL as proof of ownership for reclaiming each entry.

## QUILT DELIVERY PROCEDURES

1. Affix one COPY of the entry form to the quilt.
2. Entries must be appropriately protected for transit and storage in a fabric bag. One bag per entry. Affix a clear label with exhibitor name and category on the protective packaging.
3. Entries may be delivered in three ways:
  - i) On Monday, August 15 or Tuesday, August 16 from 9 am to 6 pm to the home of Committee Chair, Renske Helmuth (address above)
  - ii) Shipped or mailed to the above address the week of August 8, 2016
  - iii) Dropped off at the Harriston Curling Club (111 George St. South) on Wednesday, August 17 from 9 am to 6 pm.

**Entries must not arrive prior to August 1, 2016**

## QUILT PICK UP PROCEDURES

1. Entries will be available for pick up at the IPM Quilt Tent after 6pm on Saturday, September 24, 2016.
2. Any entries not picked up by 7 pm will be retained by the Committee Chair until arrangements can be made. Return expenses are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
3. You must present your ORIGINAL of the Entry Form for proof of ownership for each entry.

## QUILT COMPETITION CATEGORIES

### 1. Themed Wall Quilt: "A Fresh Taste of Quilting"

Original interpretation of modern quilting. Hand or machine quilted. Minimum perimeter 120". Prizes donated by **Undercover Quilts & More, Fergus, and Quilters' Line, Markdale.**

### 2. Themed Group Quilt: "A Fresh Taste of Quilting"

Original interpretation of modern quilting, made by two or more individuals. Hand or machine quilted. Minimum perimeter 200". Prizes donated by **Four Corners Quilters' Guild, Mount Forest.**

### 3. Pieced Quilt: Hand Quilted

Pieced by hand or machine. Hand quilted. Minimum perimeter 240". Prizes donated by **Mennonite Savings and Credit Union.**

### 4. Pieced Quilt: Machine Quilted

Pieced by hand or machine. Machine quilted. Minimum perimeter 240". Prizes donated by **Threads That Bind, Maxwell.**

### 5. Applique Quilt: Hand Quilted

Applique by hand or machine. Applique should be the dominant element of the quilt. Minimum perimeter 200". Prizes donated by **Nancy Mooney, Sales Representative, Coldwell Banker, Grand Homes Realty, Fergus.**

### 6. Applique Quilt: Machine Quilted

Applique by hand or machine. Applique should be the dominant element of the quilt. Minimum perimeter 200". Prizes donated by **Creebank Sewing Machine Shop, Mount Forest.**

### 7. Landscape or Pictorial Wall Quilt

No restrictions on size or technique. Hand or machine quilted. Prizes donated by **Royal City Quilters' Guild, Guelph, and Rosemary Terpstra, Listowel.**

### 8. Baby or Child's Quilt

No restrictions on size or technique. Hand or machine quilted. Prizes donated by **Jopie Lavrysen, Pleasant Quilting, Atwood, Quilters' Nine Patch, Quilt Shop & Rug Hooking, Elmira.**

**9. Miniature Quilt:** Must be a true replica of a full quilt. No restrictions on technique. MAXIMUM perimeter 96" Hand or machine quilted. Prizes donated by **Jason Heimpel, Auctioneer, Moorefield.**

**10. Open Class:** Any quilt not suitable for another category. No restrictions on size or technique. Hand or machine quilted. Prizes donated by **Wallenstein Feed and Supply, Wallenstein.**

**11. Youth Class:** Quilt-maker must be under 16 years by December 31, 2015. No Entry Fee. No restrictions on size or technique. Hand or machine quilted. Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$75, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$50. Prizes donated by **the Carry-On Women's Institute, Palmerston.**

### Prizes for categories 1 – 10:

1st \$200, 2nd \$125, 3rd \$75

## QUILT COMPETITION RULES

1. Submit one Entry Form and \$10 Entry Fee per entry (except the Youth Class). Entry fees are non-refundable. Both must be received by April 15, 2016.
2. Youth (under 16 years of age by December 31, 2015) may enter any category without an entry fee.
3. Entries must be entirely the work of the exhibitor, except in the themed Group Quilt category and Open Class.
4. One entry per person, per category, will be permitted.

5. Appropriate credit must be provided on the Entry Form for any design inspiration source (author, teacher, book, pattern, etc.), as per copyright rules.
6. Preprinted panels will not be accepted in any category. Embellishments are permitted.
7. Machine quilting includes domestic, longarm and computerized machine quilting.
8. Entries must have been completed after December 31, 2013. They must have a label affixed with the quilter's name and date of completion. The Quilt Committee will cover the labels prior to judging.
9. Entries must meet the specifications of the category in which they are entered. Judges will not change categories. Judges reserve the right to withhold prizes based on merit.
10. Hanging Sleeves: All quilts larger than 36" across the top, must have a secure 4" hanging sleeve. Entries smaller than 36" across the top must have a minimum 3" hanging sleeve. 11. Judging will be conducted in accordance with Canadian Quilters' Association (CQA) standards, which are available online at [www.canadianquilter.com](http://www.canadianquilter.com). Exhibitors are encouraged to review general judging standards or contact the IPM Quilt Committee chair for information.
12. Judging will take place Thursday, August 18, 2016. Decisions of the judges and Quilt Committee are final.
13. At the discretion of the Quilt Committee, all entries will be exhibited at both the IPM 2016 Quilt Show (August 19 & 20, 2016) and the International Plowing Match (September 20 – 24, 2016). They will be stored by the Committee between the two shows. Note that quilts at the IPM will be displayed under plastic for protection.
14. The Quilt Committee can assume no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected entries, or any damages occurring in transit.
15. While the IPM insurance policy will provide basic coverage for all entries while in the possession of the Quilt Committee, it is recommended that exhibitors consult their own insurance policies to ensure sufficient coverage is in place.
16. If you wish to pick up your quilt between shows, please make advance arrangements with the Quilt Committee Chair.
17. Prizes must be accepted as awarded. They are subject to change without notice, and may be awarded in cash, or equivalent goods or services.
