

Quilting Corners Past President's Challenge 2020 - Mystery Wallhanging

Part 3: Assemble Quilt Centre

1. Referring to quilt centre assembly diagram for placement, lay out the following in 8 horizontal rows:

8 solid white $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares,
the purple-and-white floral $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square,
8 purple-and-white floral HSTs,

8 dark purple floral HSTs,
4 dark purple floral $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares,
4 dark purple floral $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles,

8 light purple floral HSTs, and
16 dark-and-light purple floral HSTs in 8 horizontal rows.

2. Sew together units in each row. Sew together short middle rows (beside middle square) to make two segments. Join short segments to the sides of $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Press seams in one direction, alternating direction with each row or press seams open if desired.
3. Centre square should measure $24\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
