

# Quilting Corners Past President's Challenge 2020 - Mystery Wallhanging

## Part 4: Assemble Four Patch Units and Inner Border

### Four Patches:

Sew together 3 1/2" dark purple floral squares and 3 1/2" purple circle print squares in pairs. Press seams toward dark purple floral squares. Join pairs to make a four-patch. Four-patches should measure 6 1/2" square. Make total 8 four-patches.

### Inner Border:

1. Aligning long edges, sew together purple stripe 3 1/2" x 24 1/2" and dark purple print 3 1/2" x 24 1/2" to make short inner border unit. Press seams in one direction. Unit should measure 6 1/2" x 24 1/2". Make 4 short inner border units.
2. Referring to diagram below, sew short inner border units to opposite edges of quilt centre. Press seams towards inner border.
3. Sew a four-patch unit to each end of remaining short inner borders. Press seams away from four-patch units. Join this border to remaining edges of quilt centre. Press seams toward inner border. Quilt centre should now measure 36 1/2" square.
