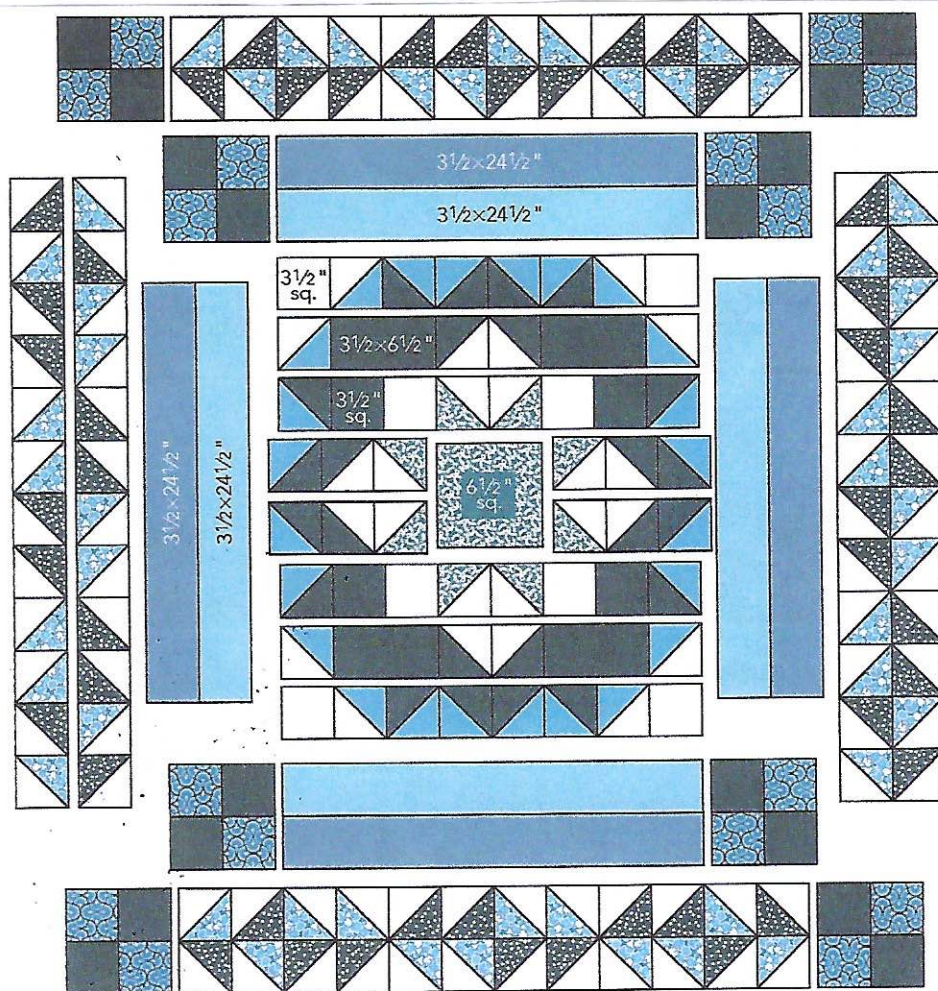


Part 5: Assemble and Add Outer Border

1. Referring to quilt assembly diagram below, lay out 12 dark purple dot HSTs and 12 purple floral HSTs in two rows. Join HSTs in each row. Press seams in one direction, alternating direction with each row. Join rows to make a short outer border. Press seam in one direction. The border should measure 6 1/2" x 36 1/2". Repeat to make 4 short outer borders.
2. Sew short outer borders to opposite edges of quilt centre. Press seams toward inner border.
3. Sew a four-patch unit to each end of remaining short outer borders to make 2 long outer borders. Press seams toward four-patch units. Add these borders to remaining edges of quilt centre to complete quilt top. Press seams toward inner border. Should measure 48 1/2" square.



Part 6: Quilt as desired and bind using your favourite method.
