QCG BOM 2021/22
September - Fillers
HSTs - $31 / 2 \prime$ (Unfinished)

We have to piece 13 HSTs to create filler strips in your quilt.

8 HSTs will be dark/background
5 HSTs will be colour 6/background
This colour scheme is based on the fabric requirements chart for the monochromatic ribbon border quilt.

Cut all your squares 3 7/8" (if you want a little extra wiggle room for trimming, cut the squares 4")

Background - 7 squares
Dark - 4 squares
Medium - 3 squares (Colour 6)

Create your units by layering all your dark and medium squares right sides together with a background square. Draw a line corner to corner on the diagonal of your background square and stitch a quarter inch on either side of the line. Cut your sewn squares on the line. Press your HSTs to the darker fabric.

You should have 8 dark/background units and 6 medium/background units. You will only need 5 of the medium ones.

Trim completed HST units to $\mathbf{3} 1 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ square and set aside. Putting them in a labelled baggy works well. We will be creating strips from these units later in our project.

## SASHING STRIPS

Cut 3 strips of background fabric - $31 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF

Subcut into the following lengths and set aside (labelled baggy)
$3 x \quad 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$1 \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
$2 \mathrm{x} 91 /$ ' $^{\prime \prime}$
$2 \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ "
$2 \times 151 / 2$ "
** To conserve fabric cut as follows:
From \#1 strip cut - $1 \times 15.5$ and $2 \times 12.5$
From \#2 strip cut - $1 \times 15.5,2 \times 9.5$ and $1 \times 6.5$
From \#3 strip cut $-3 \times 3.5$
The long strip you have left will be used in the inner border.
