### **Corner Store Information**

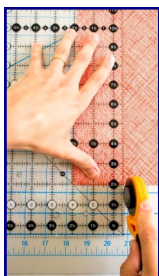
All Corner Store items should be a quilt-related, new item. Your asking price should take into account that a 15% commission is taken from the price. Items may be wall hangings, baby quilts, miniatures, table runners, placemats, quilted clothing, pincushions, bags, wallets, ornaments, tree skirts, Christmas stockings, etc. Items not sold at a previous Corner Store sale qualify for one additional year only.

- Each item must be listed and tagged individually indicating your code and the selling price.
- Items sold as sets (e. g. oven mitts, placemats) must be securely fastened together and priced /labeled as a single item.
- Print the name of the item and size on the label.
- Attach the label in a readily visible location (i. e. outside of bags).
- Bring sale items in a hard-sided bin with a lid and labeled with your name.
- Use safety pins. Straight pins are not allowed.
- Limits: - Maximum of 30 pieces of the same item (e. g. 30 bibs, 30 pin cushions). An unlimited number and variety of items is allowed.

Maximum of 2 large quilts (60” wide or larger) but you may bring an unlimited number under that size.

Pick up your forms from your guild rep at our next meeting.
