Volunteers are crucial to the success of the show. Volunteers are needed in various positions. Ask your guild rep for a form to volunteer.

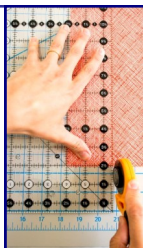

1. Only finished items will be accepted.
2. Your item must have the allowed size sleeve and a label.
3. A rod 4” longer than the wall hanging and with your name on it must accompany wall hangings.
4. Entries are limited to three items.
5. Items must be delivered to the Simcoe County Museum on Tuesday September 13, 2022 between 10 am and 1 pm.
6. Pick up is Sunday, September 18, 2022 at 4:30 pm.
7. The show committee reserves the right not to hang a quilt.
