## 8 at a Time Triangle Square

Use this method to make 8 matching triangle squares at the same time. I used 10" squares to get 8 - 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " triangles.

- 1. On wrong side of lighter square, mark diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line. Mark sewing lines ¼" away from each side of cutting line. Repeat for opposite diagonal.
- 2. Place marked square on top of darker square, right sides facing; sew along marked sewing lines.
- 3. Cut sewn squares vertically and horizontally to make four equal sections.
- 4. Cut along marked cutting lines to make eight triangle squares.
- 5. Trim squares using your preferred method and press seam allowances toward darker fabric.
