## 8 at a Time Triangle Square

Use this method to make 8 matching triangle squares at the same time. I used $10^{\prime \prime}$ squares to get $8-4 \frac{1}{2} / \prime$ triangles.

1. On wrong side of lighter square, mark diagonal line from corner to corner. This will be your cutting line. Mark sewing lines $1 / 4$ " away from each side of cutting line. Repeat for opposite diagonal.
2. Place marked square on top of darker square, right sides facing; sew along marked sewing lines.
3. Cut sewn squares vertically and horizontally to make four equal sections.
4. Cut along marked cutting lines to make eight triangle squares.
5. Trim squares using your preferred method and press seam allowances toward darker fabric.
